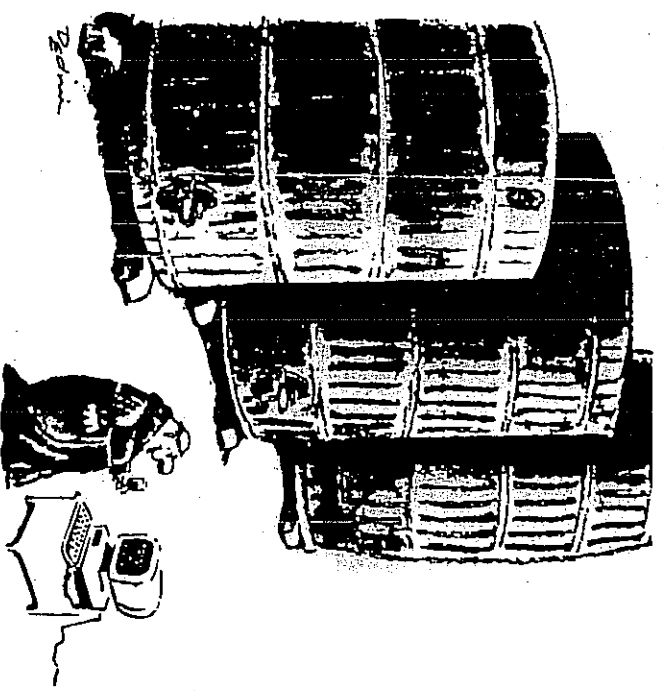

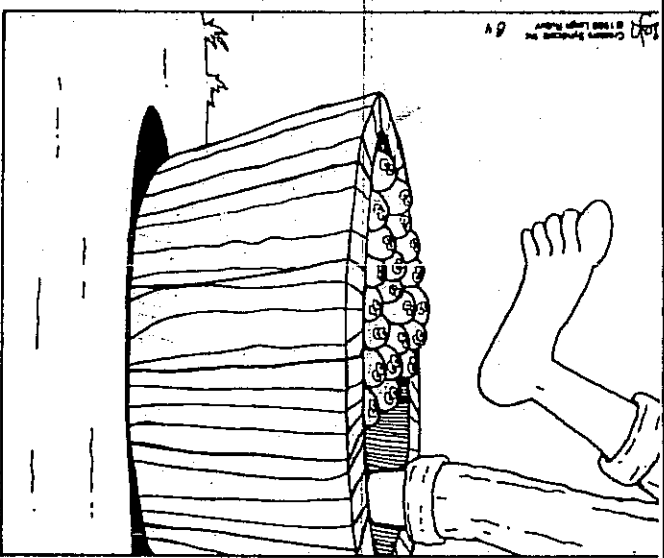
On March 24<sup>th</sup> we meet at Taylor's - no promises about lunch, but in either way lovely. See you then,
